Ideal conditions for Dust Mite growth are 25°C and 75% relative humidity – making much of Australia and New Zealand the perfect environment for them to flourish. Easy to care for

Wash your AllerProtect covers in hot water (60°C) every **2-3 months**. You can also vacuum or wipe down the covers between washes to keep allergen levels down.

Your regular bed linen should be washed in hot water every week to get rid of surface dust mites and their allergens. (A good dose of UV sunlight helps kill the dust mites, but it won't get rid of the allergens).



